

FACT SHEET: RIDESHARE FLOW ZONES

Starting May 12, 2023, Deep Ellum "Flow Zones", initially piloted in 2019 and modeled after DFW Airport to ease congestion, is expanding to Elm Street. Deep Ellum offered the first district-wide designated drop-off / pickup rideshare zone program in the country.

The new zone is next to Elm & Good and across from the new Velvet Taco, and is in addition to the other locations on Good Latimer Expressway, Commerce Street, Malcolm X Blvd, Floyd Street, and Swiss Avenue.

Rideshare Flow Zones operate in Uber and Lyft apps Friday and Saturday nights 10pm-3am and are also accessible to Alto.

Drop Off/Pick Up Zones:

Rideshare drop off/pick up zones are identified on:

- NEW: Elm Street westbound between Good Latimer Expy and I-345
- <u>Good Latimer Expressway</u> northbound between Main and Commerce Streets,
- Commerce Street eastbound between Good Latimer Expressway and Pryor Street,
- <u>Commerce Street</u> eastbound between Crowdus Street and Malcolm X Blvd.
- <u>Malcolm X Boulevard</u> northbound between Elm Street and July Alley, and
- <u>Swiss Avenue</u> westbound between N. Hawkins and Good Latimer Expressway.
- <u>Floyd Street</u> westbound between Cantegral Street and Good Latimer Expy
- <u>Good Latimer Expy</u> southbound between Florence Street and Swiss Avenue

Other Key Details:

- **Pilot Subject to Change** As this is a pilot program, the zones may expand or shift after implementation as the performance of the program is assessed.
- Effective Hours The zones will be active and enforced in the rideshare companies' apps Friday 10pm Saturday 3am. Importantly, the zones will cease operations after 3am to allow district employees to be picked up at their workplaces once peak hours of congestion have declined.
- **Zone Identification** The zones will be identifiable via City signage stating the areas are designated for ride drop off/ pick up as well as supplemental A-frame signs and bollards provided by the Deep Ellum Foundation.
- Accessibility for Persons with Disabilities Upon displaying a government issues "accessible placard," officers and security guards will enable persons with disabilities utilizing rideshare services to be dropped off/picked up without requiring use of the designated zones.
- Enforcement The zones will be enforced through a combination of technological programming, on the ground enforcement with citations for violators, and Dallas Police Department oversight.
- **Performance** Performance of the program will be tracked by Deep Ellum Foundation and its Deep Ellum Public Safety Program and supported by The City of Dallas Transportation



Department, DPD, Uber, and Lyft. Traffic flow in and around the core area of activity will be monitored and recorded to assess congestion and safety improvement. FACT SHEET: PARKING & VALET

TOP 5 PLACES TO PARK
